THE PROJECT – The Desmond, Albany Shaker Road, Town of Colonie, NY SUBJECT: IDA Application

TO: Town of Colonie IDA - Board of Directors

Prestige Hospitality Group has been retained by First Colonie Company Limited Partnership to provide a market study and opinion regarding the eligibility of The Desmond Hotel and Conference for financial assistance from the conversion of The Desmond Hotel into a Crowne Plaza Hotel flagged hotel property (the "Desmond"). Prestige Hospitality Group has years of experience preparing market studies and project viability and has actual management and marketing. We have extensive experience in marketing to groups and associations and hosting specialty events from outside the Capital Region that seek to plan and hold events at various destination locations. Our sphere of experience includes primarily the mid-Atlantic and Northeast regions of the United States including the greater Capital District area. We are available for questions and can be available for the next IDA public hearing. Our experience and qualifications are displayed on the attached corporate brochure.

In connection with the redevelopment of the Desmond and prior to the pandemic, a feasibility study was performed by CBRE, an experienced hospitality valuation and feasibility consultant (the "CBRE Report"). This report is fully supportive of the analysis set forth herein in that it sets forth the revenue impact resulting from the refurbishment and subsequent conversion into a national-affiliated hotel brand, a Crowne Plaza by IHG. Further, the CBRE Report shows the expected impact of the project on the components of the Desmond's expected revenues which are estimated to have a substantial accretive impact on revenues from outside the area (i.e. the Group and Association Business) so that it is our opinion that the Desmond is a tourism facility that is likely to attract a significant number of visitors from outside the Capital Region economic development region (Albany, Saratoga, Greene, Schenectady, Rensselaer, Warren, Washington and Columbia counties).

LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

In order to qualify for financial assistance from the Town of Colonie Industrial Development Agency, the renovated and franchise branded Desmond must be location that is likely to attract a significant number of visitors from outside the Capital Region economic development area (Albany, Saratoga, Greene, Schenectady, Rensselaer, Warren, Washington and Columbia counties) (the "Market Area"). The second criteria are that there must be a causal link between the Desmond and its facilities and the ability to attract visitors from outside the Market Area

THE DESMOND FACILITY AND LOCATION.

The Desmond is a brand name in the Market Area and is well known to residents of the Capital Region. Prior to the current renovation project, access to the Desmond was encumbered with difficult traffic movements to and from Albany Shaker Road. In the last year, the new exit ramp was completed to service the Albany County Airport. As a result of the road widening project on Albany Shaker Road, the Desmond acquired the former south bound entrance ramp on to the Northway which now serves as its main entrance. This acquisition and alignment with the traffic light has made access to and from this property significantly safer and easier. This will greatly assist the Desmond's efforts to become a primary tourism destination since it is located at the focal point entrance to the airport without encumbered access.

The Desmond is benefitted with two large courtyards which contain approximately 5,000 SF of open space. The courtyards have the look and actual operation of an all year-round open outdoor space since there are multiple skylights. The initial courtyard closer to the entrance is a threestory facility so that there is substantial light and air movement. The courtyard to the rear is a similar size but is four stories so that there is even more light and air movement. Any person that has attended an event at the Desmond has experienced the air flow and space of these court yards. The courtyards are a primary part of why the Desmond is a tourism destination. The Desmond can accommodate an event with up to 1,000 people. The physical configuration of the Desmond is unique for group, association and event business, because visitors can attend a function in the meeting rooms and then have break out meetings, events and functions in the courtyards. There are multiple tables and private areas in each courtyard. Since the onset of COVID and as a direct result of the Executive Orders from New York State, there has been no meaningful group, association and/or event business within the Market Area. We believe that there is a substantial amount of pent-up demand for group, association and event business in the Market Area. When the COVID pandemic dissipates, we believe that the Desmond will attract a substantial amount of this business, because meeting and event planners realize an "outdoor like event space" will be perceived as a better and safer alternative than conventional hotel meeting room space lacking out door light. As a result, the Desmond is in a superior position based on its unique physical attributes to capture this business. Importantly, the Desmond has always had alot of this event and group business so that coupled with its superior position at the interchange and gateway to Albany County Airport it will become the primary tourism destination project attracting substantial



number of visitors from outside the Market Area. All of the physical and locational components are at this property so that it can return to capturing out of Market Area business and visitors.

CURRENT MARKET TRENDS

Currently there is virtually no group, association and/or event busines in the Market Area as a result of Executive Orders and the COVID pandemic. As a result, all hotel properties are at ground zero (i.e. there is no group, association and/or event business). The physical facility and the older configuration of the property are now a beneficial attribute to the Desmond since it is atypical to the modern vertically constructed hotels. The Desmond has substantial amounts of well ventilated and natural light "year round space" so that it is well positioned to capture the group, event and association business that will exit from the COVID pandemic seeking what is perceived to be safer spaces. It is highly unlikely that traditional meeting room space will be highly desirable as there will be a continuing hangover impact of the COVID pandemic on travel and meeting space and all visitors will opt for the safer alternative.

CANCELLED EVENTS

As a result of the COVID pandemic, Exhibit "A" attached hereto reflects all of the group, association and event business that has been cancelled. These events are generators of business from outside the Market Area.

PRIOR OPERATING RESULTS

The Desmond enjoyed a substantive market presence that brought substantial number of visitors from outside the Market Area based on the following data. The effect of tourism dollars coming from outside the Capital District region generated by group and association business is the primary cause of this impact. The hotel at its revenue heights generated in excess of \$20,000,000 annually in the early 2,000s. During the peak period, Room revenue was in excess of approximately \$9,000,000 of which 65 percent was generated from group and association business whose attendees' residency came outside the Market Area. Food and beverage and conference fees accounted for approximately \$11,000,000 of which approximately 70 percent were related to association and group business from outside the Market Area. We expect that with the superior courtyard related facilities that The Desmond should be able to return pre-COVID revenue levels with approximately the same percentage of room and food and beverage income from outside the Market Area.

Substantially all of this business is from outside the Market Area.

CONCLUSION

The Desmond Hotel is a "tourism destination project" that is likely to attract a significant amount of group and association business and visitors from outside the Market Area that have not prior to COVID pandemic come to the Capital Region or have been absent from the Market Area because of COVID pandemic or for other reasons. In addition, the renovated Desmond facility is likely to attract specialty events drawing large number of people from outside the Market Area since there is a significant amount of demand that is currently sidelined because of the COVID related problems.

As a result, we expect The Desmond to capture an additional 37% of the Group, Meeting and Event business that otherwise would have chosen alternative markets such as Rochester, Syracuse, Buffalo, Lake Placid, etc. based on the location, physical plant and amenities the Desmond can provide. Understanding that the average traveler, according to Smith Travel Research, spends



approximately \$350 per visit, our feeling is that the economic impact is substantial in terms of visitation and spending in the market. This accounts for business that otherwise would not be traveling to the Capital Region.

SUPPORTING COMPONENTS OF THE CBRE REPORT

The following extracted pieces of the CBRE Report demonstrate the amount of Group and Association business that the Desmond was projected to capture prior to COVID pandemic and substantially all of this business was from outside the Market Area.

Desmond Hotel Conversion Study

The historical occupancies, average daily rates, and RevPARs from 2013 through 2016 for the Desmond Hotel's competitive set (inclusive of the Desmond) are summarized in the following table.

The competitive set's occupancy ranged between a high of 66.6 percent in 2014 and a low of 62.2 percent last year. Declining occupancies in 2015 and 2016 can be at least partly attributed to the addition of a total of 308 rooms at three hotels in the local area: a Residence Inn; a Staybridge Suites and a Home2 Suites, since late 2013. While excluded from the primary competitive set, it is believed that these new properties captured portions of demand historically accommodated within the competitive set.


Average daily room rates grew at a modest compound annual rate (CAGR) of 1.4 percent from 2013 to 2016, finishing last year at \$135.91. Trends in occupancy and ADR led to modest average annual growth in RevPAR of 0.6 percent.

Historical Performance of the Subject

The following table summarizes the historical performance of the Subject Desmond Albany Hotel from 2013 through 2016.

As indicated, demand and occupancy at the property increased healthily overall since 2013, reaching 55.7 percent occupancy in 2015 prior to a slight decline last year, to 53.9 percent. Management reports that this growth can be largely attributed to considerable growth in accommodated group and contract (airline crew) demand. Rising occupancy resulted in steadily increasing market penetration, from 66.4 percent in 2013 to 86.5 percent in 2016, though the property remains significantly below its overall fair share of demand.

While occupancy has risen, ADR has been in steady decline. Again, this trend can be directly attributed to growth in the group and contract segments, which are significantly lower-rated as compared to the transient segment. Rising occupancies and falling ADR combined for moderate RevPAR growth from 2013 through 2016, at a compound annual rate of 4.5 percent. The Desmond's revenue yield, which indexes its RevPAR against that of the overall competitive market, increased from 70.3 percent in 2013 to 78.8 percent last year.

Further insights into the recent historical performance of the Desmond Albany, both individually and relative to its competitive set, are revealed in the graphs on this and the following several pages.

We divided the Desmond's overall market demand penetration into individual demand segments as defined by Smith Travel Research: Transient (including individual commercial, individual leisure and government travelers); Group; and, Contract. The following graph illustrates trends in the Hotel's market penetration by segment from 2013 through 2016.

The Desmond has historically experienced significantly above fair-share penetration of the group segment, finishing 2016 at approximately 135 percent. The Desmond has a strong reputation as a high-quality group hotel and offers extensive meeting space to accommodate a wide variety of group types. Conversely, penetration of the transient segment has been considerably below fair-share, finishing 2016 at 35 percent. The soft penetration of the transient segment is indicative of the property's independent status, as individual business and leisure travelers tend to be attracted by the loyalty and incentive programs that major chains offer and are also attracted by the sense of familiarity and reliability that a major chain offers when choosing amongst lodging options. Contract penetration has increased steadily and exceeded fair share last year, at 118 percent.



Desmond Hotel Conversion Study

Management has made successful efforts to grow business within the contract segment over the past few years.

The following graph summarizes trends in the Desmond's ADR index from 2013 through 2016

The Desmond's ADR index has declined overall from 105 percent in 2013 to 91 percent in 2016, driven by varying degrees of decline in each segment.

As previously described, the Desmond has historically been more oriented to the group segment than the transient segment, a balance which reverses the experience of the competitive set. The following graphs illustrate the mix of market demand segments for the Desmond Hotel from 2013 through 2016.
